
Catholics Support the Use of Condoms to Prevent HIV




Catholics worldwide have made it clear they would like to take this affirmation of condoms even further.


We asked Catholics in Ghana, Ireland, Mexico, the Philippines and the United States 4 questions:


- Have you ever heard a Catholic priest or bishop speak out against the use of condoms?
